


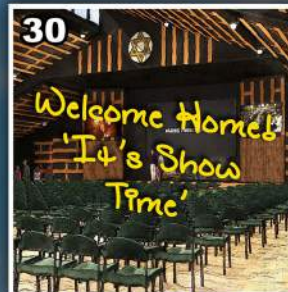

CAMP MORASHA GLOSSARY OF TERMS

A Building: The official name for the main office at Camp Morasha, housing the offices of the director, executive director, program director, and operations director, along with the registrar/office manager and her staff. Located at the entrance of camp.

Alufim/fot (Abbr: AB, AG): The divisional name for oldest campers who are coming out of the 9th grade. Literal meaning: generals.

BMP, Beit Midrash Program: We have a Boys' BMP and Girls' BMP program, each consisting of post-Israel members who spend most of their day learning while giving chaburot to our oldest campers and filling in for counselors on days off. The BMP Waiter Program waits one shift each meal.

Bondi: The 13 buildings situated between the Dining Room and Boys' Campus, where daily learning takes place.

Boys' Gym: The camp's main basketball gym, located on Boys' Campus.

Boys' Shul: A shul situated on Boys' Campus, usually only used by our boys.

Camp Time: The time followed at Camp Morasha, one hour behind city time.

Coliseum: The field across the street from the lake on the Kollel road as one enters the camp. Named the Coliseum for housing the opening and closing ceremonies for the Morasha Olympics.

Como Leagues: A 6-camp inter-camp basketball and hockey night league. There is one league for OS/Ilanot ("JV") and one for Machzor Bet ("Varsity").

DJ's: Officially known as Jericho Dairy, the popular kosher ice cream store located five minutes out of camp.

HC, Head Counselor (Office): A building located on each campus (Girls' HC and Boys' HC) through which the Head Counselor runs the campus, makes announcements, holds meetings, and distributes the mail/packages.

Ilanot (Abbr: IB, IG): The divisional name for campers coming out of the seventh grade. Literal meaning: trees.

Lake Como Pizza: The popular kosher pizza store located 5 minutes out of camp.

Lake Field: The field adjacent to the lake on the Kollel road as one enters the camp.

Machzor: A group of divisions on the same schedule. "Machzor Aleph" includes Nitzanim, Shtilim, & Ilanot. "Machzor Bet" includes Manhigim/got and Alufim/fot.

Manhigim/got (Abbr: MB, MG): The divisional name for campers coming out of the 8th grade. Literal translation: leaders.

Mercazia: Our main indoor facility, located in between Girls' and Boys' Campus, housing major camp wide events and productions.

Mifkad: An early morning ritual, where each campus lines up by the flagpole for announcements before davening.

MoraSharks: The official team name for all inter-camp sports games.

Morashia: The official name for Morasha Color War.

Nitzanim (Abbr: NB, NG): The divisional name for campers coming out of the third and fourth grade. Literal translation: buds.

Pargod: An indoor facility located on Girls' Campus, sometimes used for drama productions and rainy days.

Pavilion: Located adjacent to the Girls' Lake, used for morning t'filla, dance periods, and night activities.

Pegisha: Time on shabbat where campers and staff have free time to socialize.

Pre-Shabbat Video: A weekly video presentation shown before Kabbalat Shabbat, recapping the preceding week.

Rainy Day: An officially declared day that causes a change of schedule, often involving a later wakeup.

Senior Staff: A group of staff including Upper Staff, Department Heads, Division Heads, Ed Staff, Infirmary Heads, Day Camp Admins, and Office Heads.

Shtilim (Abbr: YSB, YSG, OSB, OSG): The divisional name for campers coming out of the fifth and sixth grades. These two ages are split into 2 divisions: Younger and Older Shtilim. Literal translation: shrubs.

Specialty Staff: A group of staff including all non-counseling staff members.

Star Day: An official day off when a shuttle is provided.

The Tank: An indoor hockey dome on Boys' Campus.

Warehouse: A group of staff with a wide range of responsibilities within the department of camp operations.

The Weekly (AKA FYI): A weekly memo issued by the programming office detailing any important changes to regularly scheduled activities.
