In this week's Parsha, Pinchas is only mentioned in the first Aliyah. The parsha continues to develop the story of Bnot Tzlafchad and the story of Moshe's successor, Yehoshua. Why do we name the Parsha after Pinchas if he is not the focal point of the story? The easy answer is because Pinchas is the first word in the Parsha.

Hne easy answer is because Pinchas is the first word in the Parsha. However, on a deeper level, Pinchas was notorious for his zealousness and taking matters into his own hands.

The Ibn Ezra explains that after the Jews participated in Avodah Zara, Hashem almost destroyed the whole nation! Pinchas's reaction, ability to lead and take action saved the Jews. As a result, Hashem rewarded Pinchas by annointing him the priesthood.

We can learn from Pinchas to rise to the occation and always do the right thing. Even more so, each individual's actions count and effects the greater community!
