Parsha Thoughts...By Rachel Bodek

In this week's parsha, Parshas Devarim, we hear about Og Melech Habashan. Hashem tells Moshe not to fear Og because He will protect him. Why would Moshe fear Og more than any other enemy? Why specifically now did Hashem have to tell Moshe not to be nervous? Rashi explains that Og was the person who came to tell Avraham that Lot was taken captive (back in Sefer bereishis). Because Og did this good deed/mitzvah, Moshe was nervous that Og might defeat בני in battle.

Rav Avigdor Nevenzhai shlita expands on this idea and says: think about Moshe Rabeinu who devoted his entire life to בני and was the leader of the בני; he was nervous that Og, who wasn't even known for his righteousness, would defeat בני because of this one good deed he did. So why was Moshe scared? After all he was Moshe Rabeinu?! The answer teaches us a great lesson. We don't understand the power of even one small mitzvah. Since Og did this mitzvah of telling Avraham- which many of us would consider insignificant- Moshe Rabeinu was nervous he would now lose the war.

Whether giving a little tzedakeh, wearing tzitzis, or smiling at someone, you have no idea the impact and reward for that mitzvah. Fulfilling even what we would consider a "small" mitzvah can have large ramifications.

As we approach Tisha B'av we can apply this idea here too. We don't know how close we are to the coming of Mashiah. Maybe we're only one mitzvah away and by smiling at your friend you will help bring the beis hamikdash. If we all remember the value of one "small" mitzvah maybe together we can bring mashiah and instead of fasting tomorrow we'll be able to dance through the streets of yerushalayim!!

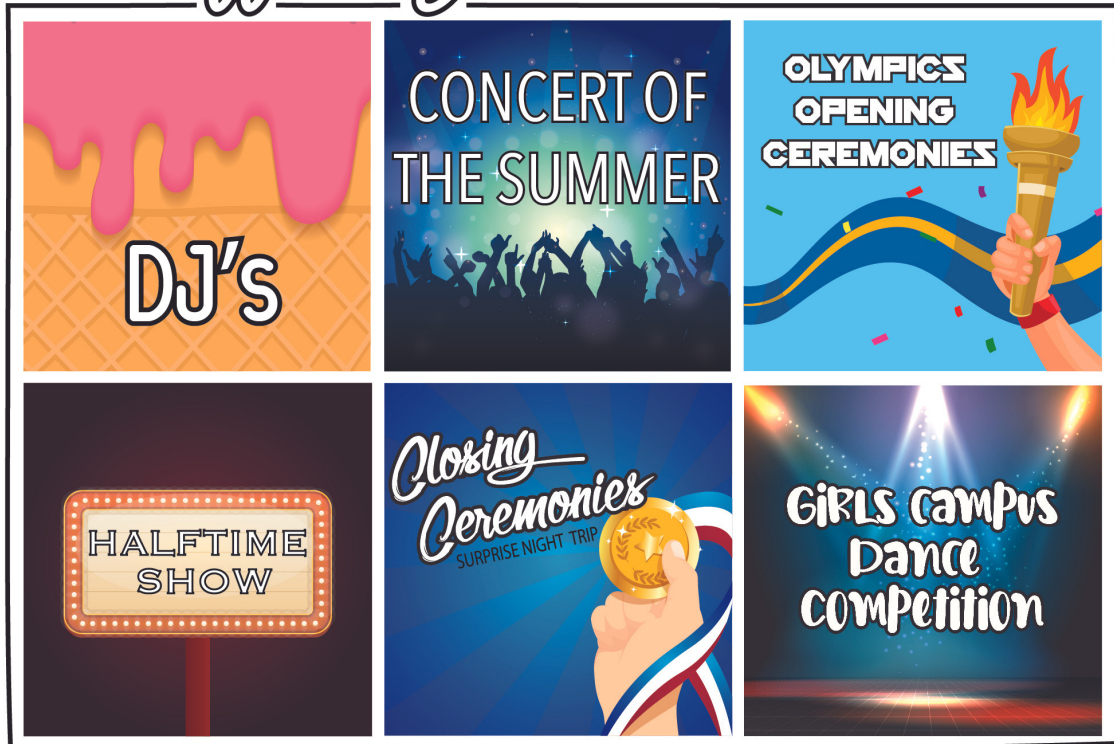
