Hashem commands Moshe to assemble an army to fight the Midianites. Rashi explains that Moshe understood that once Midian was defeated in Battle, it would be time for his death. As it states explicitly in Parshas Mattos, Moshe listens to Hashem's command with zero hesitation and forms an army to defeat Midian. Rashi explains that Hashem never gave Moshe a timetable for when he had to form the army. Why would Moshe act so quickly and not delay the formation of the army in order to extend his life? Moshe understood the importance of fulfilling Hashem's will and doing it as quickly as possible. Moshe doesn't think twice. When Hashem commands him to do something, it is done immediately. Additionally, Rashi adds that Moshe not only fulfilled this commandment immediately but he fulfilled it happily. How could Moshe do this happily? He knows he's about to die? Moshe understood that when a person serves Hashem with joy, Hashem is with him. Moshe's only desire was for Hashem to be with him and to walk with Hashem. Moshe put his anger and frustration aside, and focused solely on his desire to fulfill the will of Hashem and to be one with Hashem. We must all learn from Moshe's actions, the importance of putting our desires aside in order to fulfill Hashem's desires. We have to realize that being obedient and being united with Hashem must outweigh any of our own desires. May we all be zocheh to constantly be conscious and aware of Hashem's ratzon and be meticulous to constantly serve Hashem with joy!

A: Taco Tuesday

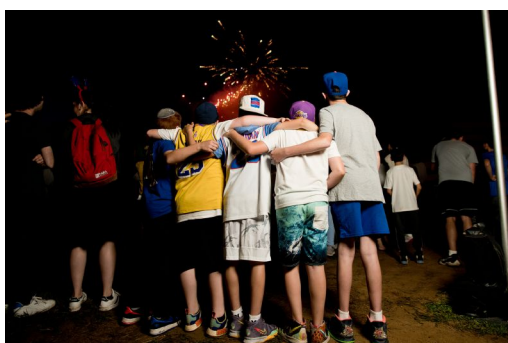
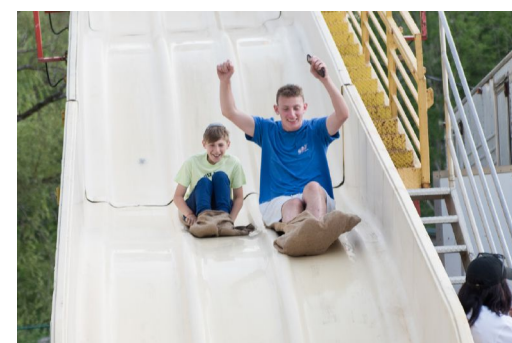
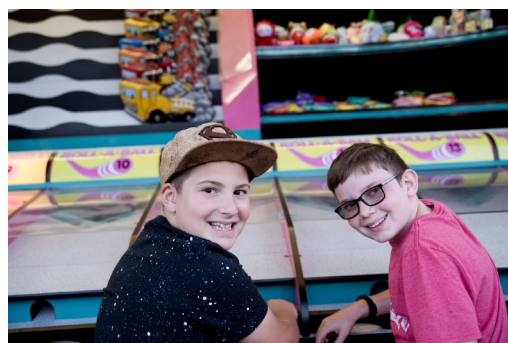
