Parsha Thoughts...Yehuda Spivak

In the opening pasuk of this week's parsha, Parshas Re'eh, the Torah states רְאֵה אֲנִי נֹתֵן לְפָנֶיךָ הַיּוֹם בְּרָכָה וּקְלָלָה ("See, this day I set before you blessing and curse.") Why does the Torah specifically state "this day", the day Moshe spoke, Hashem is placing in front of you brachos and curses? Rav Levi Yitzhak of Berditchev, the Berditchever Rebbe, points out that each and every day Hashem is recreating and constantly influencing the world. The reason why the Torah uses the wording "this day" is because each and every day we have the opportunity to feel the kedusha of Hashem and see the brachos that Hashem places all around us. This answer also follows the reasoning why the Torah specifically uses the terminology of re'eh (to see). Many times it's up to us whether to view each and every circumstance as a blessing from Hashem or to view it as a curse. We should keep this in mind, especially during Elul, a month of repentance. If we want Hashem to only focus on the good in us and forgive us of our sins, we should in turn always view the good in every situation and in every person.



