## Parsha Thoughts...Gavriel Katz (B20)

In this week's parsha, Parshat Korach, the famous story of the rebellion of Korach takes place because he believed that Moshe and Aharon made themselves greater than Bnai Yisrael for their own gain. He claimed this made them failed leaders. The death of Korach and his followers by fire and of the death of Datan and Aviram by being swallowed by the earth should have taught Bnai Yisrael an important lesson. Instead, the very next day, Bnai Yisrael blamed Moshe and Aharon for what happened. A lot of Rabbanim ask the following question: Why was Korach even angry in the first place? The Midrash Tanchuma says that Korach was angry because he resented the fact that he wasn't chosen to be a leader or kohen even though he was Moshe and Aharon's nephew. He also believed that because he was born into a 'special' family from Shevet Levi, he had status and should have led the nation. This answer given by The Midrash Tanchuma is a very great answer to the point that even Rashi commented: "This section is beautifully expounded in the Midrash of Rabbi Tanchuma." Rav Shimshon Raphael Hirsch says that Korach was angry because he believed that the whole nation was 'kedoshim' and Hashem could be found within each person. Therefore, there was no need for Aharon to sacrifice korbanot for them and no need for Moshe to relay Hashem's words. Korach wanted to be the leader of Bnai Yisrael but Moshe got the position because Hashem elected him. We learn from here that Hashem does everything for a reason and we must listen to Hashem and if Korach would have been appointed, something bad may have happened. We must realize that Hashem is controlling everything and everything happens for a good reason!
