Parsha Thoughts... Gabby Mogilner

The Lubavitcher Rebbe in his sicha on Parshas Pinchas offers a beautiful insight into the reason why Parshas Pinchas is usually read the same week as Shiva Asar B'Tammuz, the fast day marking the beginning of the Churban Beis Hamikdash. The Gemara, Yoma 9b, famously explains that the Beit Hamikdash was destroyed because of sinas chinam, baseless hatred. Unfortunately, this sin is frequent in our day too, and we therefore still are suffering through a bitter galus. Specifically during the week we fast for the Beit Hamikdash and focus on this sin, the parsha advises us how to resolve it! As a reward for Pinchas's heroic murder of Zimri and Cazbi, Hashem granted Pinchas the "covenant of peace," otherwise known as the rights to the kehuna. Along with the kehuna comes the ability and obligation to bless the nation with peace, as Hashem gave the kohanim an extra bit of love for their fellow Jews for this very reason. The lesson we learn from the juxtaposition of Shiva Asar B'tammuz and Parshas Pinchas is that it should be our priority to spread peace and love through Am Yisroel. The only way to counteract the baseless hatred which led the destruction of our beis hamikdash is with an abundance of ahavas chinam, baseless love. Over the next two weeks it is imperative for us to increase our ahavas Yisroel and try extra hard to find every possible way to express love for our Jewish brothers and sisters, and through this effort we will b'ezeras Hashem be dancing hand in hand at the third Beis Hamikdash this coming Tisha Ba'av!

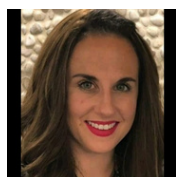
