Parsha Thoughts...Tyler Hod

"If we look at the order in which the daughters of Tzelafchad are listed here we will notice that it's not in the same order as in the earlier parsha when they first stood before Moshe.

Rashi answers this question and tells us that here the Torah tells us that they got married in order of age, and they are listed from oldest to youngest, while in Parshas Pinchos they were listed in order of wisdom, with the wisest being first and so on. Rashi concluds that the Torah varies its approach to tell us that all the girls were truly equal.

How do we understand this? If some were truly wiser than the rest that how were they equal?

Some say that there are two ways of ranking a person, either by age or by wisdom. Thus in this family the older girls weren't the brightest, while the younger ones were actually smarter than their elders. Therefore it all equals out...

But the truth is that true greatness has nothing to do with wisdom, kishronos, are a gift from Hashem, and what truly makes a person great is how they work on themselves and grow with what Hashem gave them.

Therefor while it's true that they stood before Moshe in order of intelligence but this does not reflect their level of greatness, and indeed when it came to true greatness, they were all equal."




