Parsha Thoughts....by Devorah Schreier

One of the more intriguing paragraphs in this weeks parsha is the Shiras Be'er. Bnei Yisroel sing a song to the well that gave them water for the past 40 years. A question that many meforshim ask is, why are they singing a song to the Be'er now?? They have had it for 40 years! What changed today? There are many different approaches to this answer, Rashi takes the view of the medrash, that they weren't really singing about the Be'er, but about the water that came from the Be'er that day with signs showing them that Hashem saved them from their enemy. The Netziv explains the singing now by saying that they are in the 40th year, about to enter Eretz Yisroel, so like we bench after we eat, they were singing at the culmination of 40 years. A third answer that I want to highlight now is one that I heard from Rav Assaf Bednarsh quoting the Sefer "Misinai Ba". Why are they only singing now? Because when Miriam died, the Be'er stopped. They didn't have water for a little bit of time, until Moshe hit the rock and water came forth. He explains that it is because they had it for 40 years that they are only singing now. They got used to it and didn't see it as a miracle anymore, so only once it stopped for a little bit did they realize what a big gift this well that they have is. There are many things in our lives that we have had for a long time, just because we are used to it does not mean we can take it for granted. Don't wait for it to stop to appreciate it, thank Hashem for it now. This shabbos, think of one thing that you have, even if it is something that has been around for 60 years;) and make sure to thank Hashem for it!
