Thank you for your interest in working at Camp Morasha! Staff who join us from Israel – or those finishing a year abroad as Bnot Sheirut – consistently prove to be a crucial part of our staff each summer. Each year, we receive many questions from Israeli staff regarding the application process. We've created a short Guide Sheet to help answer the most frequently asked questions.

WHAT ARE THE DATES FOR STAFF?

Our staff arrive on **Sunday, June 30** and camp ends on **Tuesday, August 20**. Almost all jobs require staff to be at camp for the entire summer. For the few jobs that we accept one session staff members, the First Session ends / Second Session begins on **Monday, July 29**.

WHAT POSITIONS CAN I APPLY FOR?

Eligible positions depend on age and/or amount of time one is available to be at camp. <u>We almost always give priority to qualified Full Summer applicants</u> before One Session applicants. Positions listed with an *asterisk **MUST** be Full Summer applicants.

HOW DO I APPLY?

Applications for all positions EXCEPT for the Mishlachat position should be submitted on our website, through the online staff application. Those interested in applying to serve on our Mishlachat team must WhatsApp Ariel Cohen at 053-339-8072 to set up an interview.

HOW DO I GET TO / FROM CAMP?

We provide busing from Long Island (Valley Stream, NY) and New Jersey (Paramus, NJ) to camp for Staff Orientation on Sunday, June 30 (and on July 29 for Second Session staff). To return home, we provide transportation to Newark Airport on both July 29 and August 20. **We do not cover the cost of flights.**
