## PARSHA THOUGHTS

When בלעם wants to curse בני ישראל, he asks Hashem for permission several times and each time Hashem says no. בלעם tries one more time, and this time, Hashem shockingly grants him permission:

“אם לקרא לך באו האנשים קום לך אתם”

“If people call you (to curse the Jews) you can go with them.”

From that response, בלעם attempts to curse the Jewish People.

The very next פסוק tells us something very strange: “ויחר אף אלקים כי הולך הוא” “Hashem became angry that בלעם went.” Why Was Hashem Angry?? Didn't Hashem give בלעם permission?

The impression בלעם got from that interaction with Hashem was that Hashem was fine with בלעם cursing בני ישראל. After all, Hashem said yes. However, as Rav Elchonon Wasserman HY”D, (Rosh Yeshiva of Baronovitch in Poland who was killed during the Holocaust) explains in his Sefer סופרים דברי סופרים, Hashem became angry because בלעם failed to recognize the true רצון השם. Rav Elchonon points to the fact that בלעם was unable to read in between the lines.

There are two primary ways that we express our desire to fulfill Hashem's will. צווי ה' which are the 613 מצוות and all of the הלכות in the שולחן ערוך are the commandments, laws and directives that govern the daily life of a religious Jew. רצון ה' is figuring out what Hashem wants from us when he doesn't spell it out for us explicitly.

In any relationship, the more that the people know and spend time with each other, the easier and more natural it will be to figure out their רצון. As the relationship develops, communication takes on the form of an unspoken language and each person can figure out what the other person wants and needs without ever having to say a single word.

Our week in camp offered and unforgettable opportunity to fulfill the רצון ה', what Hashem wants. The beautiful ספר תורה centered around a new ספר תורה and dedication of our new Shul provide a new venue for Torah Learning and Torah Reading. The person who learns Torah during his free time and gives honor to Judaism's most prized possession-the ספר תורה is the תיקון for בלעם and genuinely fulfills the רצון ה'-what Hashem wants. There is no doubt that Hashem looked down on Sunday night and saw the campers and staff energetic dancing and honoring our new ספר תורה with tremendous נחת. What a special display of רצון ה'.
